girls hair bows, pony tail bands**

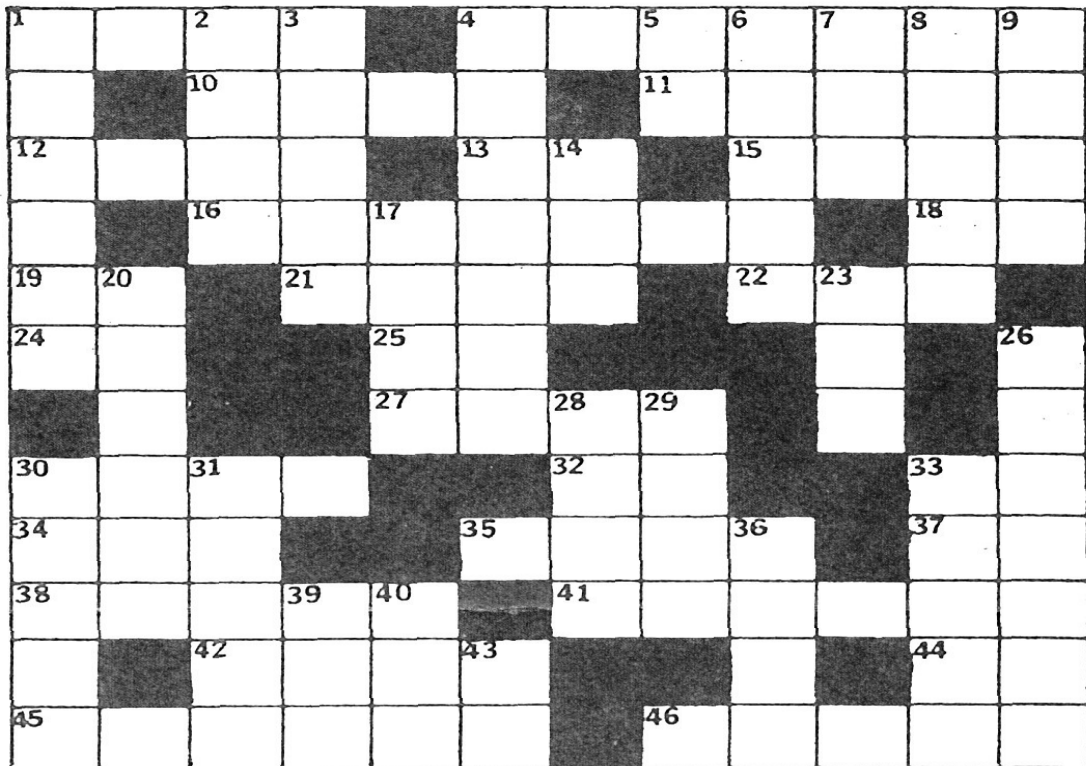
