WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A CHILD RECEIVES A SHOEBOX

Since 2009, more than 14.9 million children have reported decisions for Christ while taking The Greatest Journey. This is a 12 week discipleship course offered to the children who receive a shoebox. These children as well as those who hear the Gospel at shoebox outreach events share their faith with friends and family—who in turn disciple others.

In Colombia, a boy who came to Christ through The Greatest Journey began praying for his parents who were struggling with drug dependency. As a result, his mother and father accepted the Lord, started attending a Bible study begun by our ministry partners, and became leaders in a drug rehabilitation center. A new church was also started as an outgrowth of this ministry. "One of our original prayers was that The Greatest Journey experience would bring whole families together," said a local prayer coordinator. "And God answered!"
